The *Rights of the Fortnight* for Term 3 (2018-19) are:

14th January - Article 19 (*Linked to Holocaust Memorial Day - 27th January*)
You have the right to be protected from being hurt and mistreated, in body or mind.

28th January - Article 13 (*Linked to Safe Internet Day - 6th February*)
You have the right to find out things and share what you think with others, by talking, drawing, writing or in any other way unless it harms or offends other people.

9th February - Article 16 (*Linked to Safe Internet Day - 6th February*)
You have the right to privacy.

25th February - Article 26
You have the right to help from the government if you are poor or in need.

19th March - Article 42
You have the right to know your rights! Adults should know about these rights and help you learn about them, too.

25th March - Article 15
You have the right to choose your own friends and join or set up groups, as long as it isn't harmful to others.
